Schools Privacy Policy

We would like to remind all students that they are required to wear a sunsmart hat and sun safe clothing until the end of April. Staff and students are encouraged to wear hat styles that protect the face, neck and ears when outdoors, for example broad-brimmed, legionnaire or bucket. Caps do not provide adequate sun protection. Students who are not wearing

appropriate protective clothing or a hat may be asked to play in the shade or in a suitable area protected from the sun.



Westgarth Primary School has strategies in place to remind students to apply sunscreen before going outdoors. Each classroom has their own sunscreen and students are reminded by their teacher to apply sunscreen before recess and lunch. Students who may suffer from allergic reactions from certain types of sunscreen are encouraged to bring and use their own personalised sunscreen for school use. Please note - Singlets and tops with narrow straps are not suitable to wear at school.

Unique image codes will be issued to all students on/after photo day so families can register online to view images when they become available in the webshop.

Registration is simple, just follow the 3 simple steps on your child's personalised flyer once you receive it and remember to add the codes for all your children attending this school.

Even if you registered last year, it's important that you do again this year using your child's 2024 image code to link their images for the current year with your contact details.

When images are ready to view and in the webshop, all parents who have registered will be notified by SMS and email.



Once registered, please wait for notification that 2024 images are online to view before making your purchase.

2024 Swimming Program

All students from Prep to Year 6 will be involved in the compulsory swimming program as a curriculum component of health and physical education and personal and social capabilities of the curriculum. Students in years prep to year 4 will be bussed to and from the Ivanhoe Swimming Pool and provided with 4 lessons. Students in years 5 and 6 will participate in a session at Hampton Beach run by Royal Lifesaving Victoria.


The program is designed to differentiate so that all students' ability levels are catered for, from non-swimmers through to squad swimmers. The year 2, 5 and 6 program is held during term one. The year 1, 3 and 4 is in term 2 and the Prep program will commence in term 4. You may wish to consider altering your private swimming arrangements during these terms. As always, parents/carers are encouraged to support students by meeting the class at the pool to assist with changing.

Swimming is a healthy activity and students have great fun engaging in this different learning experience.

A free 6-session online supported parenting group for parents of children experiencing anxiety.

Open to parents living in the Cities of Darebin, Yarra, Banyule, Nillumbik and Whittlesea.

Fear-Less Triple P supports parents to learn new strategies for managing their child's anxiety. This program is for parents that are concerned about their child's anxiety that would like to learn strategies they can put in place to support the wellbeing of their child and the family.

Content is suited to parents or caregivers of children aged from 6 to 14 years.

The topics covered in this program include:

- Understanding how anxiety works,
- Becoming the best possible model of anxiety management for their children,
- · Becoming effective emotion coaches,
- Understanding and teaching the value of flexible thinking,
- Managing their children's anxiety effectively, and
- Using constructive coping.
