Well, now is your chance at the Spring Fair Craft Expo!

We are offering 4 categories and different age groups for you to compete in:

| 1 | Fruit and Vegetable Sculpture. Theme: Animals | - Prep, Grades 1 & 2 - Grades 3,4,5 and 6 |
| 2 | Flower Arrangement. Theme: Old Fashioned Garden Posy | - Prep-6 |
| 3 | Baked and Decorated Cup Cake OR small Cake Theme: Nature (You choose flavour cake) | - Prep, Grades 1 & 2 - Grades 3,4,5 and 6 |
| 4 | Art work (A4 or A3) painting, drawing, collage, Theme: Spring has Sprung | - Prep, Grades 1 & 2 - Grades 3,4,5 and 6 |

People's Choice Award

Visitors to the pavilion pay a gold coin entry fee (or 1 ticket, or wristband) and receive the opportunity to select and vote for their favourite exhibit. Voting closes 2.00pm. Winner announced 2.30pm

Prizes!

First, second, and third prizes in each category and age group. Winning entries receive a prize certificate, a rosette, and a gift!

Note for the End of the Expo

If your entry has not been collected by 4.30pm Sunday 20 October, it will be disposed of as appropriate (compost or bin). Unclaimed plates will become the property of the Kitchen Garden program!

¹ Please, no late entries accepted. If you can't make it during our submission times, you can send your submission along with a friend or family member. Remember to include your completed entry form and payment.

Entry Guidelines:

Category 1. Fruit and Vegetable Sculpture. Theme: Nature

- Must use fresh fruit and vegetables
- Can use toothpicks or wooden skewers to support/provide structure
- Maximum size: 30cm high x 25cm wide x 25cm deep
- sculpture can be 2D (flat on a plate) or 3D
- Can depict more than one animal (within size limits)
- Can make a 'scenic' entry eg 'animal in natural habitat'
- Cannot use other food types
- Entry must be placed on a plate or card, and may use on a piece of fabric or paper as liner
- Cannot use fabric or craft materials to form part of the sculpture e.g. no boggle-y eyes

Judging takes into account:

- Originality
- Humour
- Accuracy/Life-like look
- Effort

Category 2. Flower Arrangement. Theme: Garden Posy

- Must use homegrown flowers and foliage (yours or from a family or friend)
- Can use an elastic band, ribbon, raffia or string to bind the posy if needed
- Must be presented in a jam-jar with some water (large and heavy enough to be stable when on show)
- Maximum size 25cm high x 20cm wide x 20cm deep
- Do not use purchased flowers
- Do not use florist wire or tape

Judging takes into account:

- Originality
- Sense of Colour
- Style
- Effort

Category 3. Baked and Decorated Cupcake. Theme: Nature

Note: Judges will be cutting a piece from underneath to taste the cake.

- Must use home baked cupcake
- Can be any flavour
- Can use anything you like as decoration
- Must present on a plate or card (small approx. 20cm diameter)
- Can sit entry on a piece of fabric or paper as well
- Height of entry must not exceed 20cm

Judging takes into account:

- Originality
- Sense of Colour
- Humour
- Style
- Effort
- Taste

Category 4. Art work (A4 or A3) painting, drawing, collage

Theme: Now and Then - Celebrating 100 years

- An A3 or A4 art work on paper (no canvas)
- Can use any media to decorate the paper (paint, pencil, pastel, crayon, coloured paper, digital media such as procreate etc)
- It should not be framed
- It should not infringe copyright

Judging takes into account:

- Originality
- Depiction of Theme
- Style
- Effort
