# Mathematics - Strategies to number problems

Play the maths game First to Zero as outlined below. If you cannot find a die at home, please ask your teacher to borrow one.

# First to Zero

#### Focus:

Counting back / forward strategies, setting out problems using place value.

### What you need:

- 1 die (six-sided is fine), paper and pencil.

## Number of players:

2 – 3



#### How to play:

- Players decide what number to start from, for example, 20. Both players write this number at the top of their scoresheet.
- Take it in turns to roll the die. Each time you roll, take this number from your score. This becomes your new score.
- Keep on rolling and subtracting until a player reaches zero. The player must get <u>exactly</u> zero. For example, if a player is on 2 and rolls a 3, they must miss a turn.
- Be sure to set your score out in place value columns if you can!

#### How to win:

Be the first player to get to zero!
