Reading

- Ask your child to compare and evaluate two texts presenting the same ideas and analyse/explain why one is more comprehensible or engaging than the other.
- Ask your child to make create table and record examples of verb groups used by authors to represent various kinds of actions in a text:

<i>Thinking</i>	<i>Feeling</i>	<i>Saying</i>	<i>Doing</i>

Ideally, the list of verbs could be used when completing this fortnight's writing task.

Writing

- Either download/print (from the following page) or draw up a template with your child to use to help them plan their ideas for narrative.
- Have your child write an imaginative text based on characters, settings and events that he or she knows. Have your child change the point of view in a published story, revise the ending or create a sequel.
- Ask your child to re-read his/her own writing and make corrections (if needed) to clarify meaning, and correct his/her spelling and/or punctuation.
