Reading - Non-Fiction Texts

<u>Writing – Write a Script</u>

Encourage your child to compose a short script for a play. You may want to be a character in the play yourself to make it more engaging for them. Puppets or plush toys could even be used as characters for the show. Perform the play for your family and friends.

Mathematics - Data and Graphs

Check the seven-day forecast for the weather at the beginning of the week. Each day, record the actual temperature. Make some comparisons between the two sets of data and graph the results. Was the forecast accurate? What were the similarities and differences?
